



CATAWBA LODGE - ORDER OF THE ARROW UNIT ADULT CANDIDATE RECOMMENDATION

Selection and induction into the Order of an adult Scouter should take place ONLY when the adult's job in Boy Scouting or Varsity Scouting will make Order of the Arrow membership more meaningful in the lives of the youth membership. IT IS NOT FOR ADULT RECOGNITION.

Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the UNIT COMMITTEE may nominate adults to the Lodge Adult Selection Committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the currently serving unit leader (but not assistant leaders), as long as he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous twelve months. Recommendations to the Adult Selection Committee will be considered based upon the below information.
